Manager Bypass Code And Manager Bypass Key (Optional): The KPE line provides facilities managers with flexible options for managing locks. KPE models can be programmed with a 5-digit manager bypass code, which allows managers to quickly access the lock. Alternatively, managers can opt for a manager bypass key. The manager bypass key is the all-in-one tool for managing the KPE locks. A simple touch of this key to the key slot automatically opens the lock, and will also provide external power to the lock in case of battery failure. (Anticipated battery life is 3-5 years depending on model and usage).



Programming Key: Much like a smoke alarm, the KPE emits a chirping noise to alert users when its batteries run low. If the batteries aren't replaced and the lock becomes inoperable, the power jumper provides external power, allowing users to access and replace the batteries in the rear of the unit. A valid key or code is also required to gain access to the lock.



ADA User Key: The KPE model fully complies with the American With Disabilities Act guidelines set by the U.S. Access Board. All that's needed to take advantage of this functionality is for the user to be assigned a ADA User Key. Simply touch the appropriate ADA User Key to the key slot, and the lock opens. Nothing else is required, close the door and the latch shuts securely.
